8. Program summary:

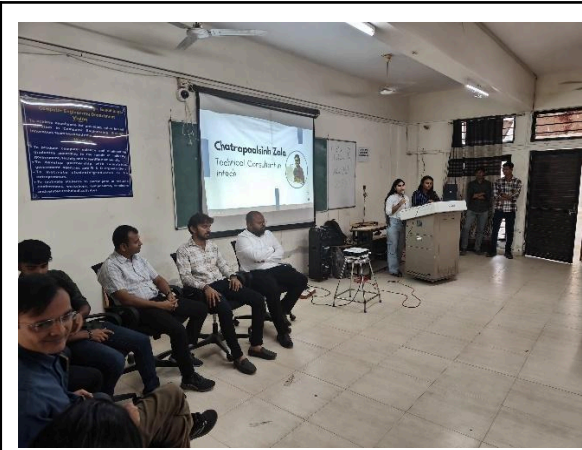
